## 1) Director's Profile:



Prof. (Dr.) Shashikala Gurpur, Director, SLS, Pune, Dean, Faculty of Law, SIU, Jean Monnet Chair Professor (EUC- LAMP co-founded by EU) has an illustrious career of over 32 years of experience in teaching, research, and industry, is continuing with Symbiosis Law School since 2007. She is a distinguished academician and orator. She received her formal schooling in Kannada medium in Gurpur, she holds degrees in science and law from Mangalore University. Dr. Gurpur received an LLM as a topper and gold medalist, and also her Ph.D. in International Law from Mysore University. She is featured amongst the illustrious 100 women personalities in the book namely 'The Phenomenal She' launched by the Indian National Bar Association on 7th March 2022 and was listed among 100 legal luminaries of India in 2016 by Lexis Nexis. ## **2) About Symbiosis Law School, Pune:**

### 3) SCALSAR:

SLSP has established the **Symbiosis Centre for Advanced Legal Studies and Research (SCALSAR)**. It is the center stage of research, quality publications, government interface, hosting scholars in residence, undertaking interdisciplinary legal studies and research projects, training teachers, and designing training modules.

SCALSAR was informally established in 2007 and was formalized and recognized as an excellence center in the year 2013. SCALSAR envisions idea architecture, infrastructure, and resources for advanced legal studies and research. It promotes research, training, and

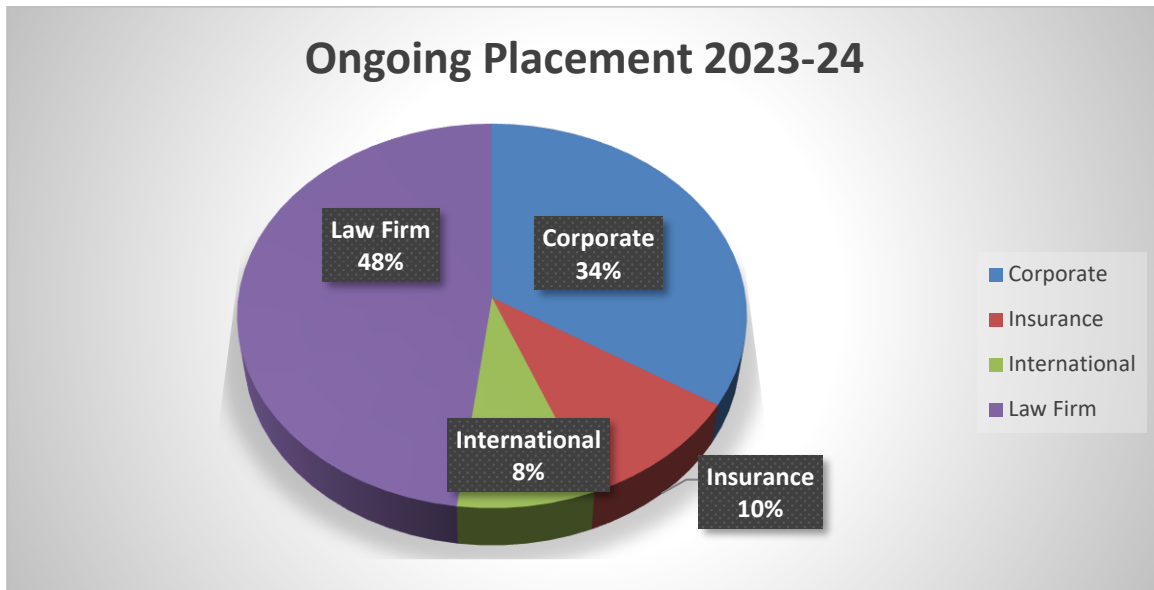

#### **4) Three-Year LL.B. Programme:**

SLS, Pune has re-introduced the three-year LL.B. programme from 2014 which has received an overwhelming response. This three-year programme is designed to impart professional legal competence to students from diverse educational backgrounds. The objectives of the programme are as follows:

- a) To equip the students with legal knowledge of various legal spheres and skills to perform various roles of a legal professional beyond the traditional role of a litigator for linking their domain knowledge to legal profession.
- b) To give them an edge over their competitors to lead so that the opportunities to shape social, public, and corporate enterprises, such as the state, community organizations and social enterprises, become justice sentinels and justice crusaders seek them out.
- c) To provide hands on experience in legal knowledge, skills, ethics, and values so as to be able to work in a fast changing India set in a globalizing world by learning law in a profound way keeping with contemporary developments.
- d) To build competence to find, identify, and interpret the law in a given situation.
- e) To enhance knowledge and enable them to resolve the legal problems with the correct application of law.
- f) To enable them to deploy IT skills and use the electronic resources to find the legal information.
- g) To demonstrate cognitive skills, problem-solving skills, analytical and independent critical thinking with enhanced research capabilities by using different pedagogical methods and collaborative online international learning.
- h) To help cultivate the ability to appreciate the role of lawyers in justice education in a globalizing world sensitive to the needs of sustainability, poverty, and vulnerability.
- i) To acquaint them with the institutions of the legal systems encompassing national, regional, and international levels and multiple aspects of dispute resolution with intellectual integrity, critical thinking, and as practice-ready lawyers.

### Step 2: All India Admission Test (AIAT)

Admission to three-year LL.B. is offered through Symbiosis All India Admission Test (AIAT). AIAT will be conducted Computer Based Test (CBT) mode on respective centres.

AIAT broadly consists of a Written Test and Personal Interaction:

#### (A) CBT Mode Test (AIAT): AIAT comprising of:

Writing sample/subjective/descriptive answer (Writing Sample: two subjective questions for 20 marks each, total 40 marks) for 65 minutes, 10 objective / multiple choice questions for 20 marks related to socio-legal, politico-legal, current and contemporary topics for 20 minutes, immediately followed by an online Psychometric Test of 20 minutes for 10 marks. There will be a time limit to answer the questions. Once the time limit is over, the candidate will lose an opportunity to answer the questions. An answer given by a candidate will be locked, so the candidate will not be able to change the answer. The candidate needs to ensure that the answer is recorded within the stipulated time limit.

The AIAT (CBT Mode) will be conducted on 11th May 2024 (Time- 2:00 PM to 3:45 PM)

**Step 3: Online Personal Interaction (PI):** There will be a total of 30 marks for PI: Personal Interaction is intended to test the personal attributes, fitment, work experience, global outlook, professionalism, ethics, values, and statement of purpose of a candidate.

A) Schedule for SLS, Pune Online PI (Personal Interaction): SLS, Pune will conduct Online PI (Personal Interaction) on 19th to 20th May 2024 for LL.B. programme.

B) Time for PI: Each candidate will get a maximum of 6 to 8 minutes for PI. The candidate needs to be ready at the given time without any excuse by following the instructions given by SLS, Pune-SIU.

Note: Candidates are requested to upload a soft copy of the Statement of Purpose (SOP), not more than 250 words, and a scanned soft copy of the Letter of Recommendation mentioning conduct, character, traits, etc. (the reference letter shall be from the



Head/Supervisor/Professor of your Institute/College) and other relevant documents as per the schedule for AIAT. After successful completion of the AIAT, candidates will be invited for the PI process provided by the institute. Candidates need to keep original documents, including the SOP and reference letter (LOR), for the PI process.
