STANDARD OF PASSING: The assessment of the student for each examination is done based on relative performance. Minimum Grade Point (GP) is 10 corresponding to O (outstanding). For all courses, a student is required to pass both internal (continuous assessment) and external examination(term end examination) separately with a minimum Grade point of 4 corresponding to Grade P. Students securing less than 40% absolute marks in each head of passing will be declared FAIL.
